

Learning @ Home Guide for Pupils and Families

At Linwood High, we understand the importance of supporting our pupils and families during these challenging times of school closure and we want our school community to know that the health and wellbeing of our pupils is a key priority for us. This guide will help both pupils and parents to better understand how to access schoolwork online and how to submit completed tasks to class teachers.

Also included are useful websites for all subject areas, online resources to support mental health wellbeing and who to contact for further help.

How can pupils access work?

We use **SHOW MY HOMEWORK** to alert pupils that work has been issued. Pupils can access this in a number of ways:

2) Every pupil at Linwood High has a *GLOW* account https://glow.rmunify.com which allows them access to several useful resources to support them with schoolwork. Pupils are able to download **SHOW MY HOMEWORK**, **TEAMS**, **MICROSOFT OFFICE**, **GOOGLE CLASSROOM** tiles on to their launch pad. 
- 3) Pupils and parents can download the **SHOW MY HOMEWORK** app on to their smartphones. Parents, please contact us at the email address above, if you require an access code.

How many hours of schoolwork? What kind of activities?


We appreciate that every child is different and their needs vary each day. Our recommendation would be that every child should be aiming for around *3 hours* of school work each day. However, it is important that pupils vary the types of activity they undertake and that they divide their learning into chunks of time, eg *20-30 mins per activity* (eg: online task, written exercise, reading, outdoor activity).

Accessing Microsoft Office


Pupils can install Word, Excel and Powerpoint onto their devices for free




How to submit tasks via SHOW MY HOMEWORK
